To answer clue 2
 BY WALKING (2mins): With your back to the plaque walk to the end of Warwick Crescent. Turn left into Harrow Rd and cross over the Zebra crossing.

2. My name is Lokamanya Tilak and I am a great Indian statesman. I lived at 10 Howley Place, W2. but my plaque has been subsumed by another of a famous artist. What name is inscribed on the visible plaque?



To answer clue 3
 BY WALKING (12mins): Go to Edgware Rd. Turn left and take the 3rd right after the flyover into Crawford Place. Cato street is the 2nd left. BY TUBE (7 Mins): Go to Warwick Avenue and take Bakerloo line to Edgware Road. (see walk)

3. My name is William Davidson and I was part of a 19th century plot to blow up members of Parliament. Our plan was foiled and we were the last people to be publicly hanged in England. What did our plot become known as?

To answer clue 4
 BY WALKING: Go back to Edgware Rd. Turn left. The 3rd left is George Street

4. My name is Mary Seacole "and by George" I am now receiving the recognition I deserve. I served in the Crimean War and I am featured in the board game, Nubian Jak. What number on George St. is my plaque?



To answer clue 5
 BY WALKING (20 Mins): Go to Edgware Rd. Turn left and walk to Marble Arch. Left into Oxford St, walk down then right into New Bond St. BY TUBE (10 Mins) Go back to Edgware Rd station. Take the Bakerloo Line to Oxford Circus. Come out of Oxford Circus station and head towards New Bond street. BY BUS (6 Mins) Take any bus to New Bond St (see walk).

5. My name is Jimi Hendrix and I am a rock icon stuck between a hard place above the perfume store Jo Malones. To my right is Fenwick's and to my left is Claridges. What Address did I live?



To answer clue 6
 BY WALKING (15 Mins): Go back to Oxford St. Turn right and head towards Oxford Circus. Turn left into Regent St on to Langley Place. 1st left is Riding House St. BY TUBE (10 Mins) Take the Central Line from Bond St to Tottenham Court Rd. Change and take the Northern Line to Goodge St. Come out of Station, turn left and take the first left to Tottenham St, the end of the road is Riding House St. BY BUS (6 Mins) Take any bus to Tottenham Ct Rd. Turn left into TCR and catch any bus to Goodge St. (see walk).
